MONTHLY REPORT—December 2020

Thank you very much for your prayers for the work of the online Chinese Bible School through the year 2020. We will continue to carry on this great work in the year 2021 no matter what the world will be. Please help us as you can to reach over a billion Chinese-speaking souls around the world.

Because of the pandemic, the Chinese Asian Bible Lectureship (CABL) in Malaysia was postponed. Instead, the board of CABL held two-half day Zoom meetings on the 5th and 12th of December titled “How to Teach Bible Class More Effectively.” In total, eight lessons were presented by five speakers. I had the opportunity to present two lessons on the 12th. My lesson titles were “How to teach topical lessons” and “How to teach the book, chapter and verses of the Bible.” In the first lesson, I presented how to rightly divide the word of truth by examining the context of the verses and the Greek words of the New Testament. Then I presented two topical lessons, “The Kingdom” and “The Home of Souls,” and explained the thought process. In the second lesson, I used Hebrews chapter one as an example of how to teach a book and chapter. Then I presented an expository lesson on John 3:16 as an example of how to teach a verse or verses of the Bible. The response from those in attendance was very positive. One individual left a comment, “I’m really happy to sit through your lesson. Brother William, such an in-depth learning lesson you taught. I’m ashamed and need to study (more). I hope to hear more from you.....” After the meeting, people greeted each other from the camera. The next CABL (2021) is also postponed due to the pandemic. We miss the time of being together and hope in year 2022 we will be able to meet again!

Our Tencent QQ online Bible study group continues to study *Church History*. This month our focus was on the reformation under Martin Luther, Ulrich Zwingli, King Henry VIII and John Calvin. In addition to telling the story of each reformer, we studied the false teachings of “faith only” and “Calvinism” and how to identify those false doctrines by rightly dividing the truth with scriptures. May the Lord bless our study and bless those students truly seeking the truth.

We are glad the proof-reading of the Chinese translation of *Searching for Truth* has been completed. All the necessary revisions have been done. The Chinese brethren in Asia are excited to hear this good news. We are in the process of collecting photos and graphics for the book to make it more oriental looking. We hope and pray that both Chinese traditional and simplified versions of *Searching for Truth* can be publicly accessible in 2021.
