MONTHLY REPORT—March 2020

Dear brethren, may this newsletter find you and your loved ones healthy and well. I pray this coronavirus pandemic would not quench our zeal to serve the Lord. On the contrary, it would strengthen our faith knowing that our Creator is in control and continues to provide what we need both physically and spiritually.

We are glad we were able to finish video recordings of *The Story of Jesus* lessons 41-47. These video lessons covered the activities of Jesus from Saturday night to Thursday night of His last week’s ministry on earth. The story started from Mary anointing Jesus to Jesus’ setting up the Lord’s supper. The video post-production, including editing the recorded video and putting together the onscreen graphics, is undergoing. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, we are working from home to continue the video post-production while getting the technical support from World Video Bible School and onscreen graphic support from brother Chin Yong in Malaysia remotely. We hope and pray that these videos can be completed and uploaded to YouTube by the end of April.

Our Tencent QQ online Bible study group continued studying the story of Jesus. The same lessons which will be on the videos are being taught online. The lessons for this month were about Jesus’ last supper with his disciples. Combining all four gospel accounts in chronological order, the students were able to obtain a vivid picture of what happened during the Passover feast: the disciples disputing who is the greatest, Jesus washing the disciples’ feet, identification of the betrayer, first prediction of Peter’s denial, the new commandment and institution of the Lord’s supper. Here are some comments from the students:

“Putting together the four gospel accounts in chronological order allows us to see clearly the story setup and understands how four gospel accounts complementary each other.”

“The Christian growth in knowledge is closely related to the Bible teacher. I am so thankful for brother Chen’s tireless teachings that my biblical knowledge is growing and making progress in these years.”

In last month’s report, I mentioned how the novel coronavirus outbreak affected many lives in China, especially in Wuhan City. It is only one month later, United States of America becomes the world’s number one victim of this pandemic. One month before, we **watched** the pain and suffering in China. One month later, we **feel** and **experience** the same pain and suffering that Chinese people went through. That reminds me of these verses, “For we do not have a High Priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.” (Hebrews 4:15-16)
