## Chinese Bible School Monthly Report — January 2026

Grace and peace to you in the Lord. As you read this January update, we hope that the coldest part of winter is beginning to pass. Late January brought an unusual combination of severe cold across North America and seasonal pollen in Texas, which caused discomfort for many people—including myself. Even so, we are deeply thankful that God continues to guard our hearts with His peace and sustain us through changing circumstances.

We are pleased to share several important ministry updates from January. During this month, we completed the editing and refinement of all nineteen lesson manuscripts for the *Second Corinthians* video course. In addition to the written manuscripts, we also finished the full slide design, visual layout, and animation production for each lesson. All of this work was completed using Apple Keynote, allowing us to present the biblical material in a clear, organized, and visually engaging way. Lord willing, we planned to begin recording this course during the first week of February. By the time you read this report, the recording process may already be completed or very close to completion.

Our Thursday evening Zoom Bible study continues faithfully each week. Beginning in January, the class officially entered into the study of *Second Corinthians*, and during the month we completed the first four lessons (1:1–3:6). Weekly attendance has ranged from approximately fourteen to twenty participants, including brothers and sisters and truth-seekers from Taiwan, Mainland China, and Malaysia. It has been encouraging to see believers from different regions studying God’s Word together and growing in faith.

We are especially thankful to share that one participant, Ms. Liu, was baptized after attending a gospel meeting in Taichung led by brother Roger Campbell. In addition, another lady was also baptized and has become our sister in Christ. We thank God for sending His servants to sow the seeds of the gospel in Taiwan and for allowing those seeds to fall on good soil and bear fruit. As Scripture says, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” (Romans 10:15).

Lord willing, Yolanda and I plan to attend the 18th Annual Asian Chinese Bible Lectureship in Melaka, Malaysia this coming June. The theme of this year’s lectureship, “Think of the Home Over There,” aligns closely with the lesson assigned to me, “The Fallacy of Premillennialism and the Correct Interpretation of Revelation 20.” In addition to participating in the lectureship, we also plan to visit and speak with congregations in both Taiwan and Malaysia. This trip provides a meaningful opportunity to encourage brethren, reconnect with family members, and proclaim the gospel across the world.

The estimated cost for round-trip airfare for both Yolanda and me is approximately **\$5,500**. If you are able to assist with this expense beyond your regular support, we would be sincerely grateful.
