Our next courses to be recorded are *James* and *Philemon*. At this stage, we have completed the manuscripts for twelve lessons in *James* and three lessons in *Philemon*. The visual production, including slides and graphics, is now moving forward rapidly. We plan to begin recording these courses during the week of April 20. Our goal is to complete and upload all videos before departing for our Asia mission trip on May 20, so that those who are eager to study the Bible will have immediate access to these materials online.

At the same time, I am actively preparing for the upcoming Asia trip. I have completed the manuscript and Keynote presentation for my assigned lectureship topic, “The Fallacy of Premillennialism and the Correct Interpretation of Revelation 20.” I have also completed the manuscripts and presentations for four bilingual (Chinese-English) gospel lessons to be delivered at the Skudai congregation in Malaysia. In addition, I am continuing to prepare for various Sunday sermons and midweek Bible classes at other congregations. I would greatly appreciate your prayers—that God will grant me wisdom, clarity, and strength as I prepare and present these lessons, so that those who hear may be strengthened and edified.

Even amid this busy season of preparation, our Thursday Zoom Bible study continues faithfully. We have now completed our study of *Second Corinthians*, and beginning in April we will transition into *James*. We thank God that more than twenty participants regularly join us each week, and we are encouraged that some are inviting new attendees to participate. It is our prayer that through these efforts, more people will come to understand the Scriptures more clearly and be willing to apply God’s truth in their daily lives—becoming lights in the world and ultimately bringing all glory to our Heavenly Father.
