The video post-productions of *Second Thessalonians* for the Traditional Chinese version have been completed. We are in the process of producing the Simplified Chinese version of the same video lessons, which will be available for viewing on our website very soon.

Our next video lessons to be recorded will cover the Book of *First Timothy*. The manuscripts for all the lessons in this study have been completed and will undergo a thorough review and revision before video recording. These materials have been utilized in our weekly Zoom Bible study.

Regarding the weekly Zoom Bible study, I have been involved in another group study. I was invited by an individual from China at the meeting of the Chinese Asian Bible Lectureship held in Malaysia in June to teach a group of approximately 100 people on Zoom every Friday at 4 p.m. (Saturday 5 a.m. in China). The majority of the people in this group are not members of the Lord’s church but have the zeal to meet online and pray every morning to sustain their faith in God under the pressure of government control in religion. So far, I have conducted six lessons of Bible study, using the study guide “Getting to Know Your Bible” by Wayne Jackson to walk through the whole Bible and the time of silence between the Old Testament and the New Testament. The lessons were well received, and with little prior knowledge of the Bible, they were amazed by the unity of the books of the Bible and how they weave together to reveal God’s great plan for man. It is my prayer that God gives me wisdom to teach these zealous people so that they may be led to the truth and become the children of God.

I appreciate your prayers and support for this crucial work of the Lord. Your steadfast commitment enables us to continue serving more than 1.4 billion Chinese-speaking people around the world. Please continue to uplift us in prayer, anticipating that our efforts in the Lord’s Kingdom will yield abundant fruit.
