Sowing the Seeds of Truth, Gathering the Fruits of Faith

Dear brothers and sisters,

Time passes quickly, and as you receive this newsletter, the year 2025 has already entered its final quarter. The world around us continues to shift with uncertainty and challenges, yet as children of God, we do not lose heart. Our hope does not rest in worldly stability but in the One who reigns over all.

The central focus of September was the completion of the *First Corinthians* video course. After months of preparation, I worked diligently to finalize the manuscripts and produce the necessary slides and graphics in Apple Keynote. This course contains twenty-eight lessons, each with 35 to 60 slides, carefully designed not only to explain the Scriptures clearly but also to keep the lessons engaging and visually meaningful. By the time you read this report, the recording of all twenty-eight lessons may already be finished. We recorded my live teaching in sync with the Keynote slides and animations, which appear at just the right moment. This approach greatly reduces post-production time while improving the overall quality of the lessons, ensuring that the Word of God is presented clearly and effectively.

Alongside this long-term work, the Lord also opened a door of opportunity close to home. On September 13, I was invited to a Chinese community potluck and Bible study in my neighborhood. The gathering was hosted by a professor at Texas State University and attended by about a dozen Chinese friends, including professionals and university faculty. Although the one leading the study had limited knowledge of Scripture, his zeal to share the gospel was inspiring. Most of the participants were from mainland China and had not yet been connected with the Lord's church. While I was not the main teacher, I was thankful for the opportunity to answer many questions during the discussion. It was a joy to see interest in God's Word arise in such a setting.

I also shared business cards containing the link to the Chinese Bible School website, hoping they will use it as a resource for further study. This small gathering reminded me once again that the harvest field of the gospel is not far away but right beside us. Whether through online video lessons or personal encounters, God is able to use His Word to draw hearts to Christ.

In summary, September was a month marked by both the completion of a major teaching project and the blessing of face-to-face outreach opportunities. These two aspects—long-term preparation and immediate evangelism—remind me of how God weaves His work together for His glory.

I sincerely thank you for your faithful prayers, encouragement, and generous support. Your love makes this ministry possible and continues to be a beautiful testimony of our fellowship in Christ. May the Lord remember your labor in His kingdom and bless you abundantly, so that together we may rejoice in Christ and share in the eternal hope.
