May the Chinese New Year (the year of the pig) find you happy and prosperous!

We are thankful *The Story of Jesus* project continues moving forward. In the first month of 2019, we have finished another four manuscripts for video lessons 25-28 on Jesus' ministry in Galilee and beyond, Peter's confession and Jesus' passion foretold, Jesus' transfiguration, and Jesus' final teachings at Galilee. The first 28 lessons of *The Story of Jesus* cover three years of Jesus' ministry and end at His final work in Galilee. We are looking forward to continuing the story of Jesus' ministry at Judea.

The Story of Jesus video lessons 17-24 have been uploaded to YouTube and published on our website at ChineseBibleSchool.org. The same videos we tried to upload to YouKu, a video hosting service in mainland China, but they were blocked due to "the improper video contents or violation of copyright" (according to YouKu's response). In order to make these videos available for the brethren in mainland China, I have sent them one at a time to our Tencent QQ Bible study group so group members are able to download the videos for personal Bible study and sharing to others as well. By the Lord's help, there are always ways to keep the gospel of Christ broadcasting.

The weekly online Bible study is still going even as the Chinese New Year is approaching. We have finished ten lessons on *Why My Savior Has to Die*. At the end of our last lesson, *The Cross of Jesus*, some expressed their gratitude of Jesus' sacrifice, and some were encouraged and said, "Thank you brother, it is indeed to me a great encouragement that helps me to press on to the goal." There is nothing more encouraging than to know the love of God and the sacrifice of Jesus on our behalf. I am grateful for the opportunity to take a small part in spreading the word of encouragement to others.

One of our Chinese videos *Where Do We Go When We Die* (the traditional Chinese version), has reached **half a million** views in January, 2019. This video was uploaded to YouTube for public viewing three years ago. It became the top viewed Chinese video online two years ago. In addition, all our Chinese videos currently online reached more than 18,000 views in the month of January, 2019.
