MONTHLY REPORT—October 2018

We are excited that the manuscripts of *The Story of Jesus* lessons 17-24 have been completed. The filming of these lessons are scheduled for the first week of November. We are thankful for the opportunity to spread the gospel of Christ to over 1.3 billion Chinese-speaking people.

The video lessons 17-24 of *The Story of Jesus* include Jesus' ministry in Galilee, the first parables of Jesus, the first commission of the twelve apostles, the death of John the Baptist, Jesus' miracles of feeding the five thousand and walking on the water, and Jesus' sermon on the bread of life. Creating the on-screen graphics is ongoing. Many thanks to the brethren who help with proofreading and providing the valuable input on lessons.

The weekly online Bible studies via Tencent QQ voice chat is ongoing. We have completed the course of ten lessons on *The Old Testament Prophecy*. I appreciate those diligent students from Taiwan, mainland China, Malaysia, and the United States joining us for this weekly Bible study. Their zeal on studying God's word reflects their love for the truth.

Our next online Bible study will be starting on November 8th. The course title is "Why Did My Savior Have to Die?" based on the book authored by Wayne Jackson. There are 10 lessons for this course. This is an in-depth study on Jesus Christ to show: Christ from Old to New Testament, the prophecy of Christ's incarnation, Christ's present reign on David's throne, our abiding kinship with the redeemer, Jesus' crucifixion, and the final act of submission of Christ to the Father. Through these studies the students may be able to comprehend "what is the width and length and depth and height—to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge...." (Eph. 3:18, 19)

Here is the prayer request on behalf of the souls in Taiwan. The same-sex marriage agenda has been promoted by those who support homosexuality for years in Taiwan and now is going to take action. The supreme court will make the same-sex marriage legal if the dissenting vote is less than a definite number (~5 million out of population of 23 million) on the 24th of November. The homosexual proponents have been implanting their agenda quietly into the school system for years. Many young generations have been indoctrinated. Even some of the young Christians have left the Lord's church because the church does not support same-sex marriage legal if the dissenting vote is less than what is required. May God bless Taiwan.
