Per request, an hour lesson titled "The providence of God" was presented to seven attendees, not members of the Lord's church, through Tencent QQ group audio meeting. This is my hope and prayer that they will continue to search the truth and let the truth set them free. May God continue to open the door through our online Chinese Bible School ministry and personal evangelism that many souls may be found and our God is glorified.
