MONTHLY REPORT—July 2020

We are thankful for your prayers for the work of Chinese Bible School. With the help of the Lord, we continue to make progress in producing biblical video lessons for more than 1.4 billion Chinese people around the world, especially as the pandemic is raging and many souls are being taken without putting on Christ.

In July, we have completed the recordings of *The Story of Jesus* lessons 48-54. These video lessons covered the farewell speech of Jesus, the Lord's prayer, the prayers in Gethsemane, the arrest of Jesus, the trials of Jesus, and the cross of Jesus. We are in the process of video post-production including video editing and putting together with onscreen graphics. Many thanks to sister Aubrie Deaver and brother Mat Cain at World Video Bible School in providing technical support. We are also thankful for brother Chin Yong in Malaysia for the production of onscreen graphics. We hope and pray that both traditional and simplified versions of video lessons can be completed and uploaded to YouTube by the end of August.

We are glad that the last manuscript of *The Story of Jesus*, lesson 58, has been completed. The final four lessons (55-58) of *The Story of Jesus* cover the stories from Jesus' burial to His ascension. The video recording of these final lessons will be scheduled upon completion of the project in hand.

Our Tencent QQ online Bible study group continued studying the story of Jesus. The lessons for this month were Jesus' burials, resurrection, and appearances. When putting all four gospel accounts together, we are able to harmonize the stories on the visits of Jesus' tomb from the women, Peter and John, and Mary Magdalene. The appearances of Jesus to many people were also discussed. I am glad that I can share what I have studied to others using modern technology. The feedback from students always is encouraging:
